PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE - PHUC HUYNH

We are definitely in the midst of winter as nighttime temperatures are hovering in the 30s to 40s for the past month and a half. Not only do we have the chilly days and nights to contend with, but the amount of rainfall that we have received since January 1st of this year can be detrimental to the cacti. Our members live in such diverse geographical areas of the Inland Empire that most of us probably have good reason to worry about how the rain deluge will affect our outdoor, exposed succulents.

The winter-growing plants, like Aloes, Echeverias, and Aeoniums will likely go unscathed by the volume of water that has come down. It's the summer-growing cacti and those succulents that need a "dry" winter rest that will be tested to their cold, wet endurance. They may look un-weathered now, but we may need a few more months to see whether they have survived the over-soaked ground. If you already have well-drained soil they will likely fare better. If your succulents are covered under dry and/or warm enclosures, remember to offer some watering for those plants which cannot be too dry during the winter rest period.

The 2023 cactus and succulent show and sale season will start this month with the first event beginning in San Diego. A listing of the tentative clubs' Show and Sale schedule is in this newsletter and on our website. Mark your calendar. You will also notice a discrepancy with the date of our club's event. **The Gates CSS Show and Sale will be on May 12 and 13**th, NOT May 5 and 6th! This is due to a schedule conflict with the facility use. May 12 and 13th will suit

A short biography of the beginnings of Rare Succulents Nursery

In early 1994 I moved from Germany to California. Back in Germany I already had a few cacti and succulents which I was growing on my window sills. At that time, I, of course, had no idea about the difference between either of them. I was still heavily involved in horses and dressage riding and was a lab tech in Pathology. Until the plants took over my life.

Shortly after moving here, one of my husbands' friends brought up the upcoming Inter City Show and Sale and we went to have a look – well, what can I say? They had to push me into the building, as I was utterly overwhelmed trying to take it all in at the same time. My collection started right there with the first 10 plants. It got the proverbial ball rolling. I found plants all over the place and eventually joined the San Gabriel club – which made things "worse". The plant addiction had taken a hold of me. It changed my life and my interests. We also started traveling to some of the habitats and my desire to grow my plants to the potential that I saw in habitat increased as well. So, I started playing around with what I could do, taking advantage of Southern California growing conditions.

Besides collecting more and more plants, I also started growing from seed and that soon filled up our little backyard in Whittier. I took over some neighbor's yards as well. Eventually we started looking for property where I could grow and in 2009 we found "The Farm ". It felt like "A Dream Come True" and little did I know or realize that I was becoming "The Slave of my own Dreams.


